- City voters approved a reduction of the board of alderman (65% passing in 6<sup>th</sup> ward)
- Working with David Merideth on cameras; meeting at Real Time Crime Center coming up soon; RTCC is back under strong leadership; cost sharing for real-time cameras
- Complaints regarding fireworks in Peabody; Christine emailed police captain
- Long-term plan regarding amenities for subsidized housing
