Lafayette Square Strategic Plan

Input is needed for the Lafayette Square Strategic Plan. The plan will establish a vision for the neighborhood & actions to be taken over the next five years to bring it to life, including consideration of a funding mechanism to support improvements identified by the community.

What is the Lafayette Square Strategic Plan?

The plan is a community informed planning effort to imagine the future of Lafayette Square & develop a roadmap for achieving our vision. The end result will be a five-year strategic plan that establishes goals, actions & potential funding strategies to support the long-term vision.

Who is doing the Plan?

The planning effort is sponsored by the Lafayette Square Restoration Committee with participation from the Lafayette Park Conservancy, the Lafayette Square Arts Council and local businesses & residents. Shockey Consulting has been hired to help develop the Plan & facilitate public engagement. An Advisory Committee of local residents & businesses is working closely with Shockey to make sure the process & the Plan itself reflect the community's interests.
